Vibrant hideaway: In Tournefeuille, France, a homeless man named David wasn't about to let his tough circumstances bring him down. Once an animator with a knack for design, David transformed his temporary shelter into something unique. Using painted foam blocks and discarded materials, he built what some have dubbed a "castle" nestled in the woods. Locals admired the structure, turning it into a small attraction. But officials deemed the dwelling unsafe and ordered it to be dismantled. Fortunately, with support from the community, David was granted an extension on the demolition deadline, hoping a better solution could be reached.

A league of two: For over five decades, two football teams in England have battled for league supremacy, but the twist is that it's a two-team competition. The Woolpack Wanderers and the Garrison Gunners are the sole participants in the Isles of Scilly Football League, likely the smallest league of its kind in the world.
